## CHLORINE OPERATORS SAFETY TRAINING LAKELAND, FLORIDA

Instruction is also provided on the operating systems, emergency response scenarios, site control and decontamination, the Incident Command System (ICS), and the practical application of chlorine release mitigation techniques in an emergency response situation.
