CRA was awarded a contract to develop Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plans (CNMPs) and provide engineering services for agricultural waste control improvements on animal feeding operations (AFOs) at various locations within the State of Utah and portions of surrounding/adjacent states for which the Utah USDA-NRCS provides technical assistance. Work under this contract is being conducted on a task order basis with an initial one-year contract period and options for four one-year renewal periods. The scope of work for the task orders includes the following activities: CNMP development; design of manure and wastewater handling and storage/treatment facilities, along with any other engineering practices needed to implement the CNMP; construction services for the installation of engineering and other conservation practices; and certification that the installed practices meet the applicable NRCS practice standards. CRA is currently in the process of conducting surveys on 21 farms throughout the State of Utah.

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
