INTEGRATED CONTINGENCY PLAN MICHIGAN

CRA prepared an Integrated Contingency Plan (ICP) on behalf of a multinational chemical manufacturer's facility in Michigan. The facility includes various material storage areas, underground storage tanks, and above ground storage tanks used for various types of chemicals, fuels, and wastes.

The ICP was prepared in accordance with U.S. EPA requirements for Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) plans, hazardous waste contingency plan and emergency procedures under Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), and State of Michigan requirements for Pollution Incident Prevention Plans (PIPP).

The ICP includes information regarding the facility and its material storage areas, procedures and practices (including training, housekeeping, inspections, record keeping, and security), available resources for spill response, notification procedures, and response procedures.

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
