## VERIFICATION OF CORPORATE REPORT TO GRI GUIDELINES

### EUROPE, NORTH AND SOUTH AMERICA

CRA supported a major global metal producer in the production of its first corporate responsibility report, conforming to the Global Reporting Initiative G3 principles for reporting.

CRA developed a data collection summary workbook, to guide the site staff in the type and extent of data required to comply with the GRI requirements for the selected indicators. Web-based training was provided to site staff, to ensure familiarity with the workbook.

CRA auditors visited each of the organization's manufacturing sites, located in Europe and North and South America, to verify the site data. A sampling approach was used to test the data for conformance with the GRI principles. A benchmarking exercise was undertaken of GRI-based corporate responsibility reports produced by other mining and metal sector companies, to provide guidance regarding the standard of reporting by competitors.

CRA subsequently verified the corporate responsibility report against the GRI guidelines. CRA's own verification process was designed to meet the GRI requirements for verifiers.
