CRA has been retained by a confidential client to conduct an initial site evaluation for the future development of wind farms in Illinois. CRA is assessing local interest in wind farm development; identifying suitable locations for development; liaising with landowners, state, and local officials; and managing projects as they move through the planning, development, and permitting phases.

Based on CRA's initial assessment and discussions with landowners in Illinois, two wind farms with installed capacities of approximately 200 MW each are being concurrently developed. Future project phases include execution of grid-integration studies, avian/bat habitat assessment work, execution of anemometer studies, and continued attendance and support at landowner meetings.

This work will continue for the next several years.

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
