The City of Owen Sound has initiated the planning process to determine the wastewater treatment services needed to upgrade the City's existing Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP). The Owen Sound WWTP is located at 2050 3rd Avenue East in Owen Sound.

The project is being executed according to the requirements of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007). Public consultation is being conducted to provide those affected and interested in the project with an opportunity to participate and provide input.

A Public Information Centre has been scheduled to provide the community with background information on the project and to discuss options being evaluated. A preferred planning alternative will be identified for public comment. Final selection of the preferred alternative will occur once all public and government comments are received.
